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| 01  | Kindly advise regarding Annexure G.<br>We are a QSE. Is there another form for the sworn affidavit?  | Please note that we have only provided the EME sworn affidavit template<br>because the bid is within the construction sector. According to the Amended<br>Construction Sector Codes published in Notice 931 of 2017 of Government<br>Gazette No. 41287 on 1 December 2017 ,Qualifying Small Enterprises<br>(QSE) including bidders with a total annual revenue more than R1.8 million<br>in the case of Built Environment Professionals (BEP) and more than R3<br>million in case of Contractor or Supplier where majority of their core activities<br>is in the construction field are required to submit a SANAS accredited B-<br>BBEE certificate. |

| 03  | Why are no Wetland, Hydropedology, Hydrology, Geohydrology specialist study updates required?  | The specialist studies have been confined to those requested by DFFE as<br>part of Construction EMPR. Please note that the EIA has addressed this and<br>other pre-construction studies such as the Geotech and Water use licence<br>process will address these. Therefore, they are not part of the specialist<br>studies required for this RFB.   |

| 04 | Annexure C1 to C5 in the tender document contains tables to be<br>completed regarding Specialist experience. However, no table is<br>included for the noise and air quality specialists.<br>Must the bidder add additional C6 and C7 tables for the noise and<br>air quality specialists respectfully? | A decision was taken to evaluate only the criteria that is included in the evaluation criteria (i.e. company experience, environmental lead and the specialist mentioned and the corresponding C1 to C5 table has been included. The noise and air quality specialist do not form part of the functional criteria but are part of the studies required and are included in the pricing schedule.                             |
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| 05 | Can TCTA provide us with a more defined study area for the specialist report updates. This is for the specialist to provide a more accurate quote. The area provided by TCTA is very large and thus the Specialist will have to work on a worst-case scenario  | Layout plan provided in addendum no.4 which indicate Ntabelanga dam and associated roads which is the focus of the initial part of phase 2.  |

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| 09 | As part of the biodiversity quote, must we include an amount for the application of permits for plants to be removed?   | No, the removal of plants and the permit thereof will form part of the construction contractor's scope   |
| 10 | As part of the Biodiversity Report update, is one report update<br>required to be updated or are there numerous separate biodiversity<br>reports requiring update. It is our experience that often the<br>biodiversity component is separated into a Botanical Assessment<br>Report, a separate Ecological Assessment Report (including<br>amphibians, reptiles, aves etc) and a separate Aquatic Assessment<br>Report. Please elaborate. | The biodiversity report has to include the fauna and flora, you can have sections in the biodiversity report addressing these.<br>The Aquatic monitoring forms part of the Biomonitoring report, which is a separate specialist study.   |
| 11 | Is there an existing Biomonitoring Report?  | Yes, the biomonitoring forms part of the aquatic specialist report found in the project link that was provided in addendum no.2 <a href="https://www.dws.gov.za/iwrp/mzimvubu/IAP.aspx">https://www.dws.gov.za/iwrp/mzimvubu/IAP.aspx</a>  |
| 12 | For the construction and operational phases, how many biomonitoring surveys should we include or for what time-period?  | The scope of the Biomonitoring specialist in the RFB does not include doing biomonitoring during the implementation phase of the project. That will be done either by DWS or PSP. The Biomonitoring during the Operational phase will be done by DWS or an agent that they would have appointed. |
| 13 | Can you please expand on what is meant by micro and macro scale water quality monitoring?   | It is not micro and macro water quality monitoring but the parameter grouping into macro and micro water quality parameters. The water quality parameters to be tested have been provided in point no.6 of this clarification and addendum no.4.   |
| 14 | Are only baseline air quality results required or a full Air Quality<br>Impact Assessment?  | The RFB requires an air quality specialist study which should comprise of baseline information, air quality related impacts that are expected from the construction activity and the associated mitigation measures which can be referred to as an Air quality Impact assessment.                |

Ntabelanga dam has a crest wall = 425m and Dam Wall = 68m which is classified as a large dam and comes with stringent risk measures.</li> <li>Staff houses for operational staff at the dam site.</li> <li>Five new flow measuring weirs will be required in order to measure the flow that is entering and released from the dams.</li> </ul> |

| 17 | There's some mention of power generation – by what means and<br>to what end will power be generated (hydro for the national grid vs<br>standby power from fossil fuel combustion for the water and<br>wastewater treatment and potable water pumping) | <ul> <li>Associated infrastructure [Authorisation no. 14/12/16/3/3/678]</li> <li>The hydro power generation will be done later and does not form part of this RFB. Eskom will conduct their own environmental studies if the power generation will utilise fossil fuel.</li> </ul>   |

Or we must hand write the<br>information? | The Information can be typed or handwritten, bidders must ensure that the forms are signed. |
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| 20 | Will bidders be disqualified if they propose the same key personnel for the same bid?   | Bidders will not be disqualified.   |
